This position will work closely with the studio leadership team in a variety of projects: urban design, architecture, urban planning, and civic participatory processes. This position is **based in San Antonio**, and will entail collaboration with our studio in Chicago.

This position seeks candidates with 3-5 years of professional experience (either or combined) in architectural design, urban design or urban planning coupled with excellent visual representation capabilities, public speaking, research and community engagement skills.

What you'll do

- Research and Documentation
 - Develop technical, qualitative and quantitative design research
 - Create spatial analysis and strategy summaries, visuals and graphics
 - Develop technical and creative writing
- Urban Planning and Community Engagement
 - Engage in project management, community outreach, fostering strong project relationships with stakeholders; and delivering/facilitating project presentations
 - Collaborate with design of engagement process and materials

- Collaborate in creating inclusive and accessible community engagement exercises (preparation, organizing, facilitate) with diverse populations to gauge and understand community concerns and aspirations
- Facilitate small and large public meetings
- Deliver external presentations and participate in speaking engagements
- Document meeting minutes and milestones
- Manage project hours and production budgets in coordination with studio leadership
- Urban and Architectural Design
 - Develop concept-level plans, studies, and drawings in collaboration with design team - examples include:
 - Existing site analysis and spatial diagrams (2D and 3D)
 - Conceptual renderings or photo collage of proposed design
 - Measured and dimensioned drawings of proposed design
 - Summary presentations of research
 - Prepare presentations, visuals and other formats of design communication
 - Overseeing printing, production, and fabrication of deliverables

 - Three to five years of experience in community design (architecture, landscape architecture or urban design).
 - Ability to work in-person (San Antonio)

 - Proficient in MS Office, Google Docs, Adobe Creative Suites, especially InDesign, and ideally Illustrator and Photoshop
 - Proficiency in 2D and 3D modeling and rendering software such as Rhino,
 AutoCAD or similar.
